

IMPORTANT Reimbursement update, provided by Click Medical, as of November 2026

There are 2 active Level 2 HCPCS codes that properly describe the addition of RevoFit® to Lower Extremity and Upper Extremity prosthetic sockets. The final decisions published by CMS are summarized as follows.

FROM CMS (Lower Extremity):

- Establish a new HCPCS Level II code *L5783, "Addition to lower extremity, user adjustable, mechanical, residual limb volume management system"* to describe RevoFit®
- Primary Medicare Benefit Category – Artificial Leg (prosthetic)
- **2026 Medicare fee schedule amount - \$3,150.07**
- Pricing Indicator = 38
- Effective Date – April 1, 2024

FROM CMS (Upper Extremity):

- Establish a new HCPCS Level II code *L7406, "Addition to upper extremity, user adjustable, mechanical, residual limb volume management system"* to describe RevoFit®
- Primary Medicare Benefit Category – Artificial Arm (prosthetic)
- **2026 Medicare fee schedule amount - \$3,150.07**
- Pricing Indicator = 38
- Effective Date – April 1, 2025

NOTE: On January 13, 2026, CMS added L5783 to the Master List.

- Generally items are added to the master list when the following happens - 30% increase in utilization year over year and/or \$1m over 1000 or more billings to medicare
- Being on the Master List does mean prior authorization is required, but it is common for Master List items to be considered for future PA requirements
- Click recommends thorough and accurate Medicare documentation and medical-necessity rules (written order, clinical record supporting need, item description, supplier documentation).
